

## Children/Youth Outdoor Events (3<sup>rd</sup> grade and above)

***A waiver will need to be signed by both parents of each child/youth attending event.***

- All events must be made at the church or a venue, no personal homes can be used
- Age 8 and older only
- The leader of children's and youth outdoor activities will review the Covid-19 Screening Questions with parents each time they drop their child or youth off for these activities. In the case of older youth who come on their own, they should be asked the Screening Questions upon arrival at all activities. If any of the questions are answered yes, the child or youth may not participate in the activity and must return home
- Masks are required unless social distancing can be maintained
- Food can be served but must be prepackaged, individual drinks, no food sharing, gloves must be worn by the adult handing out the food/drinks
- Leader would wipe down the picnic table tops and seats before use
- Bathrooms
  - Only the men's room at the entrance of Faith House will be open
  - One person at a time in the bathroom
- Firepit
  - Masks would be required when sitting around the fire pit as proper social distancing would not be able to happen
  - Leaders would wipe down the seats prior to the event
- The Leader will be the person in charge to make sure the protocols are adhered to
- Pool parties can only happen at a commercial setting not at a personal home.
