GENERAL GUIDELINES

We cannot accept any items that are broken, unusable, not working properly, torn and/ or extremely worn, have a mildew, moldy, or cigarette smell, stained, or are otherwise in disrepair.

We will immediately dispose of any items donated from the "will not accept" lists.

Other items we will not accept:

- · Clothing of any kind
- Food (other than for the deli/bakery and café)
- · Guns or ammunition of any type
- Medical equipment including braces, canes, crutches, bedside commodes, walkers, wheelchairs, etc.
- Musical instruments
- Paint, motor oil, pesticides, poisons, or any other substances considered to be toxic, highly flammable or otherwise hazardous.
- · Saws of any kind
